Westmoreland Conservancy Public Use Policy

The parking area at each Westmoreland Conservancy reserve is to be accessible to mobility disability devices. The trails at the Nature Reserves are specifically designed to have minimal impact on the surrounding environment and are natural surface, which may include tree roots, narrow passages and steep slopes. To alter the trail would significantly alter the protection/preservation of the landscape, and therefore no vehicle powered by battery or other engine is permitted access. Manually operated mobility devices are permitted at the user's risk.
