2026 Winter Campaign

We have big plans for 2026 and beyond and need your help to make them happen.

2026 Project Highlight: A Meadow in the Making at Morosini Reserve

At the Morosini Reserve, visitors enjoy the Universal Pedestrian Trail (UPT)—an accessible, treelined path designed for individuals with mobility challenges. A parallel mowed trail offers a grassy alternative, ensuring inclusive access for all. Just below the UPT and the Wildlife Observation Blind lies a field with extraordinary potential—ready to be transformed into a vibrant native meadow. Our vision is to restore this area using native wildflowers and grasses to:

- Support birds, pollinators, and small mammals
- Improve ecological diversity and resilience
- Create new opportunities for education, observation, and exploration

This multi-year restoration project will involve mowing, tilling, and reseeding to replace existing switchgrass with a diverse mix of native species—bringing seasonal beauty and long-term environmental benefits to the reserve.

Together, we can turn this open field into a living landscape that thrives for generations.
